EXPANDED RESOURCES OF SANBAG LOCATIONS

Kings County continues to provide sandbag resources due to flooding in parts of the county. Sandbag locations have expanded in areas of Lemoore and Stratford. The following sandbag locations are available throughout the county:

- County of Kings - 10871 Bonneyview Ln. Hanford, CA 93230 (24-hour access)
- City of Hanford - 900 S. 10th Ave. Hanford, CA 93230 (Monday-Friday, 7:30a.m.-5:00p.m.)
- City of Corcoran – 750 North Ave. Corcoran, CA 93212 (Monday-Friday, 7:00a.m.-4:00p.m.)
- City of Lemoore – Corner of F. St. and Fox St. (24-hour access)
- City of Avenal - 108 W. Kings St. Avenal, CA 93204 (24-hour access)
- Stoney's Sand and Gravel - 9181 CA-41 Lemoore, CA 93245 (Available during business hours)
- Kings County Fire Station 6 - 7735 21st Ave. Lemoore, CA 93245 (24-hour access)
- Kings County Fire Station 10 - 20200 Main St. Stratford, CA 93266 (24-hour access)

Sandbag locations are available to residents for no cost. Residents are to bring their own shovel and only take resources that is needed at the self-service sandbag locations. It is recommended that sandbags are filled $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ to effectively prevent water out than bags that are completely full.
